PARAPHRASING What is paraphrasing? A paraphrase restates a passage's ideas in your own words The author's meaning is retained, but your own wording, instead of the author's, is used In paraphrasing, you must pay careful attention to the meaning of the original passage, yet express the same idea in a different way

#### **Paraphrasing and Summarizing Sources**

Paraphrasing Paraphrasing means that you are rewording what someone else has said using about the same number of words but not the same phrasing or sentence structure When you like the details of the text but don't want to quote it word for word, paraphrasing is the ...

#### **Summary and Paraphrase Summary**

Paraphrase, like a summary, is a rewording of the original source using the writer's own words and sentence structure Unlike summary, paraphrase covers the detail and complexity of the original text A paraphrase is usually about the same length as the original text Paraphrasing restates the author's ideas but does so in new language

#### **PARAPHRASING - Potsdam**

Even though the paraphrase is in your words, the original idea is not yours If you don't cite your paraphrase, you're stealing the source's content So every time you paraphrase, put an in-text citation in the sentence, and always include all of the information for the source in your bibliography

#### **Paraphrasing for Academic Honesty**

Simple effective paraphrase: Lester (1976) claims that research papers should not have too many direct quotations, at most 10% of the paper. But students tend to copy too many quotes from the original sources. While taking notes, he suggests it's better to keep direct quotations to a minimum (46-47)

### **Principles of Paraphrasing**

Paraphrasing Correctly • When paraphrasing another author's text you must: - Accurately reflect the author's message - Cite the author's last name - Note the year of publication - Use your own words - Use your own sentence structure

### **Summarizing, Paraphrasing, and Synthesizing Sources**

Paraphrasing works well when ideas need clarification for your audience or when the style of the content isn't consistent with your writing style. When paraphrasing, be careful to use your own words, sentence structure, and phrasing to avoid inadvertent plagiarism. To paraphrase pictures, drawings, or ...

### **Why paraphrase?**

Tips for Writing Paraphrases 1) Paraphrase only passages or parts of passages that are key to your purpose 2) Put the source's ideas into your own words (using your own style and word order) 3) Be true to the meaning of the original 3) Do not add to the source material when writing your paraphrase 4) Quote only sparingly (if at all) 5) Use tags to keep reminding your reader you're paraphrasing
