Lexical and Syntactic Analysis • Two steps to discover the syntactic structure of a program – Lexical analysis (Scanner): to read the input characters and output a sequence of tokens – Syntactic analysis (Parser): to read the tokens and output a parse tree and report syntax errors if any 2

Syntax Analysis The syntax analysis portion of a language processor nearly always consists of two parts: – A low-level part called a lexical analyzer (mathematically, a finite automaton based on a regular grammar) – A high-level part called a syntax syntax analyzer, or parser (mathematically, a

Lexical analysis may require to "look ahead" to resolve ambiguity Look ahead complicates the design of lexical analysis Minimize the amount of look ahead FORTRAN RULE: White Space is insignificant: VA R1 == VAR1 DO 5 I = 1,25 DO 5 I = 125
