Britten selected texts based on old English carols and poems, many anonymous and mostly dating from the 15th and 16th centuries Britten conceived of the work as a ceremony, and it opens and closes with processionals set to the plainsong chant "Hodie Christus natus est" in unison voices This chant also forms the basis of the harp Interlude
