Static vs. dynamic scheduling Dynamic scheduling

- Static scheduling (optimized by compiler) - When there is a stall (hazard) no further issue of instructions - Of course, the stall has to be enforced by the hardware
- Dynamic scheduling (enforced by hardware) - Instructions following the one that stalls can issue if they do not produce structural hazards or dependencies Dyn Sched
