Exposure to Violence Children can be exposed to violence in one of three ways: direct victimization, witnessing violent incidents, or witnessing the aftermath of violent incidents Further, exposure to violence can occur in a number of domains, such as in the home, in the community/neighborhood, or in the school, among others
