The War in Europe World War I left unresolved the question of who would dominate Europe The tremendous dislocations caused by the war laid the groundwork for the collapse of democratic institutions there and set the stage for a second German attempt at conquest A worldwide depression that began in 1929 destroyed the fragile democratic regime
